Required Documents

All documents must be submitted to commence the process with a notarized translation to English or Hebrew of all documents, and with an Affidavit as detailed below that has been certified in accordance with the Israeli Notaries Law, 5736 – 1976. This means (a) by an Israeli notary, (b) by an Israeli consul or (c) by a notary in the State where the certificate was given. In the third case, the document must be legalized as an Apostille (if the country is a member of the Hague Convention), or if not, legalized by that State and also by the Israeli consulate in that State. If this requirement is not met in full, THE APPLICATION WILL NOT BE DEALT WITH UNTIL THE REQUIREMENTS ARE MET IN FULL.

A Foreign Law Firm registered/listed as a corporation must submit an Affidavit of a member stating as regards the Foreign Law Firm that:

- A. Its sole propose to provide legal services.
- B. Its center of activity is overseas
- C. A list of all its members and partners licensed to practice law in the originating State/country.
- D. A list of all its members and partners **who are not** licensed to practice law in the originating State/country.
- E. Whether the firm shares its income with whomever is not a licensed lawyer
- F. Whether the firm has full liability for all its members.

Foreign lawyer self employed must submit:

- A. A current and valid license to practice law from a Foreign Bar Association.
- B. An Affidavit stating that his/her center of activity is outside the State of Israel, and whether the lawyer shares his/her income with anyone who is not a licensed lawyer.
